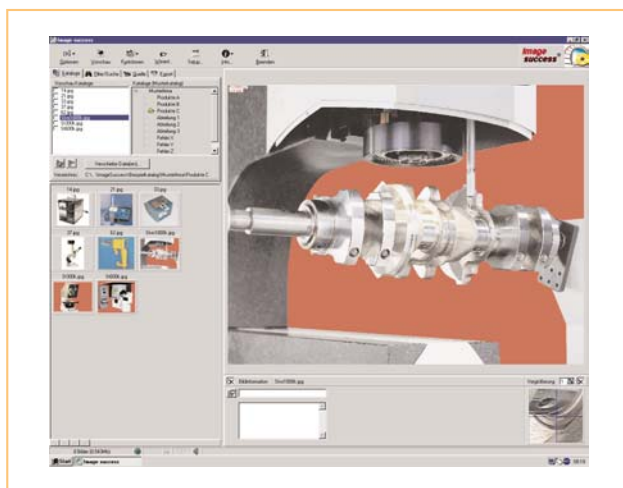


# Image Success



## Image Administration

Image Success serves for the easy and quick transmission of image files of digital data sources on hard disks in freely configurable catalogues or for the visualization of existing image files. Administrating your digital images is facilitated by a little number of clear operational elements.

### Features of performance

- Comfortable catalogue function.
- Diapositive show.
- Creation of image dictionaries for the transmission (e.g. printing service) or storing (CD/Server).
- Preview window with small thumbnail pictures for the easier allocation of the pictures to the corresponding catalogues.
- Intersecting point to external programs that allow lossfree shooting, processing or reproducing of short films.
- Possibility of putting down short texts and remarks to each picture.
- The image formats BMP, JPEG, GIF and the uncompressed TIFF are supported as well as their interacting transformation.
- Magnifying glass function.
- Transmission of image files by E-mail (editable drafts).
- Opening of the pictures in the Internet browser with the stored image information (editable drafts).
- Comfortable storing function within networks.
- Search function for texts.
- The broadly available TWAIN intersection, the intermediate deposit as well as the AVI intersection serve as image data source.
- Support of the operating systems WIN 98, NT, 2000 and XP.
- Operating ability with at least Pentium I processor as from 166 MHz with 32 MB RAM. It is recommendable using Pentium II with 64 MB RAM. Also, the clock frequency should be higher than 233 MHz.
